Free Upgrades with new technologies



Summary:

Whiteley Village is a retirement village, set in a 250 acre site in Surrey. In early 2011 Whiteley Village approached Evolving Networks with a view to improving the quality of internet service provision across the site.

The project was focussed on providing high capacity, resilient Internet access facilities to the Offices, Care Home and Extra Care facility, as there was a requirement for higher speed access and to ensure that bandwidth could be increased further in future as the needs of the users grew.

With a local fibre network already in place, it was proposed to centralise IP transit via a Bonded ADSL2+ solution. This entailed taking the fastest connectivity available locally and presenting multiple ADSL tails as a single, bonded link.

Upgraded Bonded Solution:

Bonded FTTC & ADSL 2+

Upgrade Path:

Evolving Networks initially delivered a 2 x Bonded ADSL2+ service to Whiteley Village. This delivered a substantial increase in the available upload & download capacity, as well as addressing some instability issues that had been affecting the site previously. Evolving Networks subsequently upgraded the Bonded ADSL2+ service, as soon as FTTC (Fibre To The Cabinet) ADSL was supplied to site.

The Bonded ADSL2+ service was upgraded to incorporate fibre broadband at no additional charge, with no drop in connectivity and without the need for any local IP settings to be altered.
